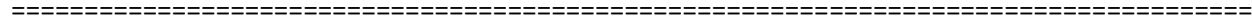
As always the gift exchange was a lot of fun with some great gifts! Everyone there seem to have a great time.



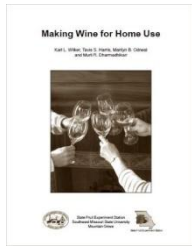
January 10th at DEER SPRINGS WINERY
