and a have short meeting at 7 pm.

What to do: The Frontenac grapes for the club wine will be picked, crushed and

de-stemmed by members at Bart's vineyard. There are about 40 plants. We should get 5 to 6 gallons of must so 5 or so teams of 2 or more club members each should be arranged and take the must home or where ever the team captain lives. The teams will ferment and bottle the Frontenac wine they make, and sometime next year we will have a contest with experienced judges to pick the best wine made.
